Titration is a testing method that determines the concentration of swimming pool chemicals by using a standard concentration of a known reagent. The standard reagent solution is called the titrant. There must be a way of determining when the balance or endpoint is reached to know the test is complete. They understood pool water chemistry and problem solved with intelligence.



These days virtually all pool stores relay on what a computer spits out, willy – nilly and often without having any real understanding of the chemistry in your pool. Just blindly follow the computer's words "of wisdom" but at whos' cost? – Yours!
